Warrior Week is a free, tailored transition program for active-duty service members preparing for separation/retirement and recently transitioned veterans, designed to launch you into a meaningful civilian career. Warrior Week helps you translate your military experience into a purpose-driven work life that fits who you are and where you want to go.

By week's end, each participant leaves with renewed clarity, redefined values, and personalized goals to guide their next steps in a meaningful path forward professionally and personally.



WHO IS THE IDEAL CANDIDATE?

- ✓ Active-duty within two (2) years of separation or veteran within five (5) years of separation*
- ✓ Looking for a job, looking to advance in their current organization, or looking to find meaningful community support/volunteer roles.
- ✓ Ready to take ownership of their next chapter and build a purposeful, fulfilling life beyond the uniform.
- ✓ Seeking practical tools, clear direction, and personalized support to thrive in the civilian workspace.
- ✓ Highly motivated and ready to take intentional, actionable steps toward a future marked by clarity, confidence, and impact.
